The Jackson Cup, named in honor of the late Past Commodore Dr. Robert F. Jackson, (1993-'94), is an annual invitational team race challenge by the Boston Yacht Club to other clubs and organizations. The teams selected for the challenge are chosen for having demonstrated high racing skill and the Corinthian spirit. The event was inaugurated in 1999 and is held in April each year. It is sailed in Sonar class boats in Marblehead Harbor.

Eight teams of three will race with one or two round robins followed by a medal round to keep everyone racing over the two days. This year the teams are: The Boston Yacht Club, Corinthian Yacht Club, Eastern Yacht Club, New York Yacht Club, Royal Thames Yacht Club, Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club, St. Francis Yacht Club, and the Southern Yacht Club.
